

Psalm 118:15

The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents of the righteous; the right hand of the Lord does valiantly. (NKJV)

Songs of joy and victory are sung in the camp of the godly. The strong right arm of the Lord has done glorious things. (NLT)

The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents and private dwellings of the [uncompromisingly] righteous; the right hand of the Lord does valiantly and achieves strength. (AMP)

Voice:

Qowl-to call aloud; a voice or sound.

Rejoicing:

Rinnah-a creaking (or shrill sound), i.e. shout (of joy or grief).

Salvation:

yeshuw` ah-something saved, i.e. (abstractly) deliverance; hence, aid, victory, prosperity.

Tents (tabernacles in KJ):

'ohel-a tent (as clearly conspicuous from a distance): covering, (dwelling) place), home, tabernacle, tent.

Right hand:

Yamiyn-the right hand or side (leg, eye) of a person or other object (as the stronger and more dexterous); locally, the south.

Valiantly:

Chayil-a force, whether of men, means or other resources; an army, wealth, virtue, valor, strength.

Scripture references:

Psalm 26:7

That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving, and tell of all your wondrous works.

Psalm 42:4

When I remember these things, I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go with the multitude; I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of joy and praise, with a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast.

Psalm 66:8

Oh, bless our God, you peoples! And make the voice of his praise to be heard,

Psalm 107:22

Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.
