



Psalm 132:9

“Let your priests be clothed with righteousness, and let your saints shout for joy.” NKJV

Priests:

Kohen-one officiating, a priest; also (by courtesy) an acting priest (although a layman)

Clothed:

Labash-wrap around, i.e. (by implication) to put on a garment or clothe (oneself, or another), literally or figuratively

Righteousness:

Tsedeq-the right (natural, moral or legal); also (abstractly) equity or (figuratively) prosperity

Saints:

Chaciyd-kind, i.e. (religiously) pious (a saint)

Shout aloud for joy:

Ranan-to creak (or emit a stridulous sound), i.e. to shout (usually for joy)

Scripture references:

Psalm 132:16

I will also clothe her priests with salvation, and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

Psalm 30:11

You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; you have put off my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness...

Psalm 4:5 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the Lord.

Psalm 15:2

He who walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart...
