“Behold, bless the Lord, all you servants of the Lord, who by night stand in the house of the Lord! Lift up your hands in the sanctuary, and bless the Lord.” NKJV

Bless:

Barak-to kneel; by implication to bless God as an act of adoration

Servants:

`ebed-servant

House:

Bayith-house, especially family

Lift:

nasa'-to lift

Hands:

Yad-the open hand

Sanctuary:

Qodesh-a sacred place or thing

Scripture references:

Psalm 26:12

My foot stands in an even place; in the congregations I will bless the Lord.

Psalm 63:4

Thus I will bless you while I live; I will lift up my hands in your name.

Psalm 68:26

Bless God in the congregations, the Lord, from the fountain of Israel.
