



## Psalm 13:5-6

*“But I have trusted in your mercy; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, because he has dealt bountifully with me.”*

### **Rejoice:**

Guwl- properly, to spin round (under the influence of any violent emotion), i.e. usually rejoice, or (as cringing) fear.

### **Trusted:**

Batach-to hie for refuge; figuratively, to trust, be confident or sure.

Hie means to go quickly; hasten or hurry.

### **Salvation:**

Yeshuw` ah-something saved, i.e. (abstractly) deliverance; hence, aid, victory, prosperity

### **Sing:**

Shuwr-the idea of strolling minstrelsy; to sing

### **Mercy:**

Checed-kindness; by implication (towards God) piety: rarely (by opposition) reproof, or (subject.) beauty

### **Bountifully:**

Gamal-to treat a person (well or ill), i.e. benefit or requite; by implication (of toil), to ripen, i.e. (specifically) to wean

You might interpret this psalm like this: “I have come quickly to you, Lord, for refuge and am confident and sure of your kindness. With all my being, everything that makes up me, will spin (dance) around with violent emotion because you have delivered me and given me victory. I will sing to the Lord everywhere I go because he has treated me well by loading me with benefits.”

### **Scripture references:**

Psalm 9:14

That I may tell of all your praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion. I will rejoice in your salvation.

Psalm 20:5

We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all your petitions.

Psalm 21:1

The king shall have joy in your strength, O Lord; and in your salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!

Psalm 35:9

And my soul shall be joyful in the Lord; it shall rejoice in his salvation.

Psalm 52:8

But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.

Psalm 59:16

But I will sing of your power; yes, I will sing aloud of your mercy in the morning; for you have been my defense and refuge in the day of my trouble.

Psalm 62:8

Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us.

Psalm 96:2

Sing to the Lord, bless his name; proclaim the good news of his salvation from day to day.

Psalm 101:1

I will sing of mercy and justice; to you, O Lord, I will sing praises.

Psalm 116:7

Return to your rest, O my soul, for the Lord has dealt bountifully with you.

Isaiah 12:2

Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; for Yah, the Lord, is my strength and song; he also has become my salvation."

Isaiah 25:9

And it will be said in that day: "Behold, this is our God; we have waited for him, and he will save us. This is the Lord; we have waited for him; we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation."

Revelation 19:7

Let us be glad and rejoice and give him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his wife has made herself ready."
