

Psalm 138:4-5

All the kings of the earth shall praise You, O Lord, when they hear the words of Your mouth. Yes, they shall sing of the ways of the Lord, for great is the glory of the Lord.

Praise:

Yadah-literally, to use (i.e. hold out) the hand; physically, to throw (a stone, an arrow) at or away; especially to revere or worship (with extended hands); intensively, to bemoan (by wringing the hands)

Hear:

Shama'-to hear intelligently (often with implication of attention, obedience, etc.; causatively, to tell, etc.)

Words:

'emer-something said

Mouth:

Peh-the mouth (as the means of blowing), whether literal or figurative (particularly speech)

Sing:

Shiyr-through the idea of strolling minstrelsy]; to sing

Ways:

Derek-a road (as trodden); figuratively, a course of life or mode of action

Great:

Gadowl-great (in any sense); hence, older; also insolent

Glory:

Kabowd-weight, but only figuratively in a good sense, splendor or copiousness: -glorious (-ly), glory, honour (-able)

Scripture references:

Yes, all kings shall fall down before Him; All nations shall serve Him.

So the nations shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth Your glory.
