



Psalm 32:11

“Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, you righteous; and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!”

“So rejoice in the Lord and be glad, all you who obey him! Shout for joy, all you whose hearts are pure!” (NLT)

“Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, you [uncompromisingly] righteous — you who are upright and in right standing with him; shout for joy, all you upright in heart.” (AMP)

Glad:

Samach-to brighten up, i.e. (figuratively) be (causatively, make) blithe or gleesome

Rejoice:

Guwl-to spin round (under the influence of any violent emotion), i.e. usually rejoice

Righteous:

Tsaddiyq-just

Shout:

Ranan-to creak (or emit a stridulous sound), i.e. to shout (usually for joy)

Upright:

Yashar-straight, convenient, equity, Jasher, just, meet, pleased well, right, upright

Radical translation: “Cheer up all of you who love the Lord with all your heart, soul, mind and strength. Dance and whirl before the Lord with all your might and make some joyful noise while your doing it.”

Scripture references:

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in you; let them ever shout for joy, because you defend them; let those also who love your name be joyful in you.

Psalm 132:16

I will also clothe her priests with salvation, and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

Psalm 13:5

But I have trusted in your mercy; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation.

In your name they rejoice all day long, and in your righteousness they are exalted.

Let all those who seek you rejoice and be glad in you; let such as love your salvation say continually, "The Lord be magnified!"

This is the day the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalm 33:1

Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! For praise from the upright is beautiful.

Psalm 64:10

The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in him and all the upright in heart shall glory.

Psalm 111:1

Praise the Lord! I will praise the Lord with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright and in the congregation.

Psalm 140:13

Surely the righteous shall give thanks to your name; the upright shall dwell in your presence.
