



## Psalm 56:10

*“In God (I will praise His word), in the LORD (I will praise His word)...” NKJV*

*“I praise God for what he has promised; Yes, I praise the Lord for what he has promised.” NLT*

### **Praise:**

Halal-to be clear; to shine; hence, to make a show, to boast; and thus to be (clamorously) foolish; to rave; causatively, to celebrate; also to stultify

### **Word:**

Dabar-a word; by implication, a matter (as spoken of) or thing; adverbially, a cause

### **Promise:**

Epaggelia-an announcement for information, assent or pledge; especially a divine assurance of good

You might say it like this: “I will boast about, be clamorously foolish and celebrate the Lord for the word he has spoken.”

The bible is full of the promises; spoken words of God. To list them here would take pages. However, maybe the most important of God’s promises are the promise of sending his son, the promise of the Holy Spirit, the promise of eternal life and the promise of his return. These promises alone are enough to earn our most violent praise.

Along with these scripture references you might consider reading Romans 4 and Galatians 3.

### **Scripture references:**

Acts 13:23

From this man's seed, according to the promise, God raised up for Israel a Savior -- Jesus --

Galatians 3:14

...that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Ephesians 1:13

In him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise...

2 Timothy 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus...

Hebrews 9:15

And for this reason he is the mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

1 John 2:25

And this is the promise that He has promised us -- eternal life.

Ephesians 3:6

...that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel...

Hebrews 4:1

Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it.

2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:13

Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
