



Psalm 66:2-4

“Sing out the honor of his name; Make his praise glorious. Say to God, ‘How awesome are your works! Through the greatness of your power your enemies shall submit themselves to you. All the earth shall worship you and sing praises to you; They shall sing praises to your name.’” Selah (NKJV)

“Sing about the glory of his name! Tell the world how glorious he is. Say to God, ‘How awesome are your deeds! Your enemies cringe before your mighty power. Everything on earth will worship you; they will sing your praises, shouting your name in glorious songs.’” Selah (NLT)

Sing (praises):

Zamar-through the idea of striking with the fingers; properly, to touch the strings or parts of a musical instrument, i.e. play upon it; to make music, accompanied by the voice; hence to celebrate in song and music

Name:

Shem- through the idea of definite and conspicuous position; an appellation, as a mark or memorial of individuality; by implication honor, authority, character

Honor & Glorious:

Kabowd-properly, weight, but only figuratively in a good sense, splendor or copiousness: - glorious (-ly), glory, honour (-able)

Praise:

Tehillah-laudation; specifically (concretely) a hymn: a hymn of spontaneous praise

Worship:

Shachah-to depress, i.e. prostrate (especially reflexive, in homage to royalty or God)

Selah:

Celah-suspension (of music), i.e. pause: Amplified Bible reads, “pause, and calmly think of that!”

Scripture references:

Psalm 7:17

I will praise the Lord according to his righteousness, and will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High.

Psalm 9:2

I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.

Psalm 18:49

Therefore I will give thanks to you, O Lord, among the Gentiles, and sing praises to your name.

Psalm 44:8

In God we boast all day long, and praise your name forever. Selah

Psalm 54:6

I will freely sacrifice to you; I will praise your name, O Lord, for it is good.

Psalm 61:8

So I will sing praise to your name forever, that I may daily perform my vows.

Psalm 68:4 Sing to God, sing praises to his name; Extol him who rides on the clouds, by his name YAH, and rejoice before him.

Psalm 72:19 And blessed be his glorious name forever! And let the whole earth be filled with his glory. Amen and Amen.

Psalm 22:27 All the ends of the world shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you.
