



Psalm 75:1

“We give thanks to you, O God, we give thanks! For your wondrous works declare that your name is near.” (NKJV)

“We give praise and thanks to you; O God, we praise and give thanks; that you name is near your wondrous works declare, and they who invoke your name rehearse your wonders.” (AMP)

“We thank you, O God! We give thanks because you are near. People everywhere tell of your mighty miracles.” (NLT)

Thanks:

Yadah-use (i.e. hold out) the hand; physically, to throw (a stone, an arrow) at or away; especially to revere or worship (with extended hands)

Wondrous works declare:

Caphar-to score with a mark as a tally or record, i.e. (by implication) to inscribe, and also to enumerate; intensively, to recount, i.e. celebrate

Near:

Pala'-to separate, i.e. distinguish (literally or figuratively); by implication, to be (causatively, make) great, difficult, wonderful

This psalm, attributed to Asaph, is similar in context to Psalm 72:18-19. In essence he says, “We extend our hands in reverence and worship to you God because everything that you have made; all that has been tallied and recorded, can be recounted as proof that only you could have made them. In fact, they speak for themselves.”
