



Psalm 89:15

“Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! They walk, O Lord, in the light of your countenance.” NKJV

“Happy are those who hear the joyful call to worship, for they will walk in the light of your presence, Lord.” NLT

Blessed:

'esher-happiness; how happy!

Joyful Sound:

teruw` ah-clamor, i.e. acclamation of joy or a battle-cry; especially clangor of trumpets, as an alarm

Light:

'owr-illumination or (concrete) luminary (in every sense, including lightning, happiness, etc.)

Countenance:

Paniym- the face (as the part that turns)

Those who know the sound of joy; those who have experienced and observed it, will walk in the illumination of God's face.

Scripture references:

Psalm 4:6

There are many who say, "Who will show us any good?" Lord, lift up the light of your countenance upon us.

Psalm 44:3

For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, nor did their own arm save them; but it was your right hand, your arm, and the light of your countenance, because you favored them.

Psalm 27:6

And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy (teruw` ah) in his tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord.
