



Psalm 96:11-12

“Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness; Let the field be joyful, and all that is in it. Then all the trees of the woods will rejoice before the Lord.”
(NKJV)

Rejoice(1):

Samach-to brighten up, i.e. (figuratively) be (causatively, make) blithe or gleesome

Glad:

Giyl-to spin round (under the influence of any violent emotion), i.e. usually rejoice

Roar:

ra`am-to tumble, i.e. be violently agitated; specifically, to crash (of thunder); figuratively, to irritate (with anger)

Joyful:

`alaz-to jump for joy, i.e. exult

Rejoice(2):

Ranan-to creak (or emit a stridulous sound), i.e. to shout (usually for joy)
