



Psalm 98:1

“Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! For he has done marvelous things; His right hand and his holy arm have gained him the victory.” (NKJV)

“Sing a new song to the Lord, for he has done wonderful deeds. His right hand has won a mighty victory; his holy arm has shown his saving power!” (NLT)

Sing:

Shiyr-through the idea of strolling minstrelsy; to sing

New:

Chadash-new; fresh; new thing

Song:

Shiyrah-a song; abstractly, singing

Marvelous:

pala'-perhaps to separate, i.e. distinguish (literally or figuratively); by implication, to be (causatively, make) great, difficult, wonderful

Right hand:

Yamiyn-the right hand or side (leg, eye) of a person or other object (as the stronger and more dexterous); locally, the south

Holy:

Qodesh-a sacred place or thing; rarely abstract, sanctity

Arm:

zerowa`-the arm (as stretched out), or (of animals) the foreleg; figuratively, force

Victory:

yasha`-to be open, wide or free, i.e. (by implication) to be safe; causatively, to free or succor: at all, avenging, defend, deliver (-er), help, preserve, rescue, be safe, bring (having) salvation, save (-iour), get victory

You might read this verse this way: “Sing to the Lord a fresh new song because he has done things that separates and distinguishes him from all others. With his strength and holiness he has reached out and displayed his freeing power.” (not a literal translation)

Scripture references:

Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

He has put a new song in my mouth -- Praise to our God; many will see it and fear, and will trust in the Lord.

Oh, sing to the Lord a new song! Sing to the Lord, all the earth.

I will sing a new song to you, O God; On a harp of ten strings I will sing praises to you...

Psalm 33:3

Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, and his praise in the assembly of saints.

Isaiah 42:10

Praise to the Lord Sing to the Lord a new song, and his praise from the ends of the earth, you who go down to the sea, and all that is in it, you coastlands and you inhabitants of them!

Revelation 5:9

And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for you were slain, and have redeemed us to God by your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation..."

Revelation 14:3

They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth.

Psalm 9:1

I will praise you, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will tell of all your marvelous works.

Psalm 105:5

Remember his marvelous works which he has done, his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth...

Psalm 139:14

14 I will praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are your works, and that my soul knows very well.

Psalm 17:7

Show your marvelous lovingkindness by your right hand, O you who save those who trust in you from those who rise up against them.

Psalm 18:35

You have also given me the shield of your salvation; your right hand has held me up, your gentleness has made me great.

Psalm 20:6

Now I know that the Lord saves his anointed; he will answer him from his holy heaven With the saving strength of his right hand.

Psalm 44:3

For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, nor did their own arm save them; but it was your right hand, your arm, and the light of your countenance, because you favored them.

Psalm 63:8

My soul follows close behind you; your right hand upholds me.

Matthew 12:20

A bruised reed he will not break, and smoking flax he will not quench, till he sends forth justice to victory...

1 Corinthians 15:57
