



Psalm 99:9

“Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the Lord our God is holy.”

Exalt:

Ruwm-to be high actively, to rise or raise

Worship:

Shachah-to depress, i.e. prostrate (especially reflexive, in homage to royalty or God)

Holy 1:

Qodesh-a sacred place or thing; rarely abstract, sanctity

Hill:

Har-a mountain or range of hills (sometimes used figuratively)

Holy 2:

Qadowsh-sacred (ceremonially or morally); (as noun) God (by eminence), an angel, a saint, a sanctuary

I will worship toward your holy temple, and praise your name for your lovingkindness and your truth; For you have magnified your word above all your name.
