

## **Magnify**

**Hebrew:** Gadal-to twist; to be or make large in body, mind, estate, honor, and pride; increase, lift up, advance, boast, bring up, exceed, excellent (sometimes translated magnified).

Psalms 34:3 Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt His name together.

Psalms 69:30 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving.

Psalms 40:16 Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, "The LORD be magnified!"

**Greek:** Megaluno-to make great, increase, extol, enlarge, show great (sometimes translated magnifies and magnified).

Acts 10:46 For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God...

Luke 1:46 And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord..."

Acts 19:17 This became known both to all Jews and Greeks dwelling in Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.
