

## **Rejoice**

**Hebrew:** Samach-to brighten up, cheer-up, make glad, make merry.

Psalms 31:7 I will be glad and rejoice in Your mercy, for You have considered my trouble; You have known my soul in adversities...

Psalms 96:11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; Let the sea roar, and all its fullness...

Psalms 105:3 Glory in His holy name; Let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the LORD!

Other references: Psalms 5:11; 33:21; 85:6

**Hebrew:** Guwl-to spin around, under the influence of any violent emotion.

Psalms 21:1 The king shall have joy in Your strength, O LORD; And in Your salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!

Psalms 32:11 Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous; And shout for joy, all you upright in heart!

Psalms 118:24 This is the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.

Other references: Psalms 2:11; 9:14; 13:5

**Hebrew:** Ranan-to creek, to emit a stridulous sound, to shout aloud for joy.

Psalms 20:5 We will rejoice in your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the LORD fulfill all your petitions.

Psalms 33:1 Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous! For praise from the upright is beautiful.

Psalms 71:23 My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing to You, and my soul, which You have redeemed.

Other references: 65:8; 90:14; 98:4

**Hebrew:** Suws-to be bright, cheerful, be glad, make mirth.

Psalms 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the LORD; It shall rejoice in His salvation.

Psalms 40:16 Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, "The LORD be magnified!"

**Greek:** Chairo-to be cheerful, happy or well off, God speed, hail, joy.

Luke 19:37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen...

Romans 12:15 Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice!

**Greek:** Agalliao-jump for joy, exult, be exceedingly glad with joy (sometimes translated rejoiced).

Luke 1:47 And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

Luke 10:21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight.

Revelation 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."
