

## **Song**

**Hebrew:** Shiryah-a song, singing, musical song.

Psalms 33:3 Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Psalms 40:3 He has put a new song in my mouth--Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, and will trust in the LORD.

Psalms 69:30 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving.

**Hebrew:** Zimrath-a musical piece, song to be accompanied by an instrument, melody, praise.

Isaiah 12:2 Behold, God is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; For YAH, the LORD, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.

**Greek:** Oide-a chant or ode; general term for any words sung (sometimes translated songs).

Revelation 5:9 And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation...

Ephesians 5:19 ...speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord...

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
